

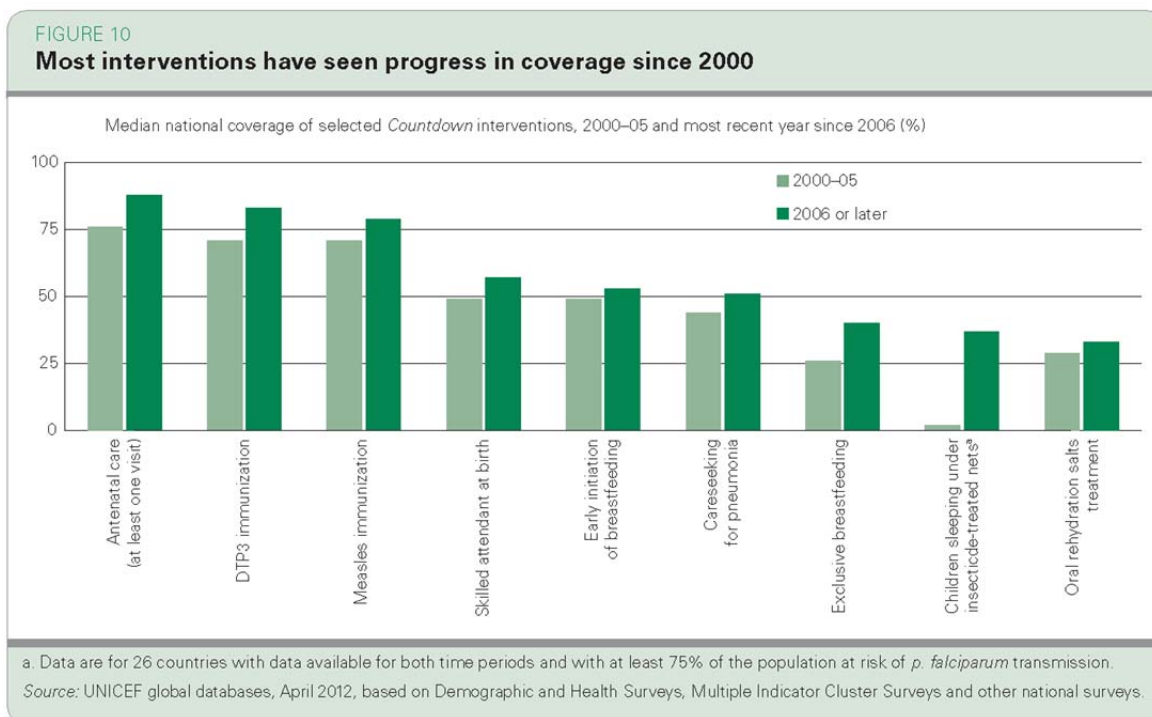
**Countdown 2012 Report: Building a Future for Women and Children**  
**Errata for the printed version, June 2012**

- Page 9, box 4: The table on data availability in Countdown countries should appear as below, with corrections to data in the last 2 lines:

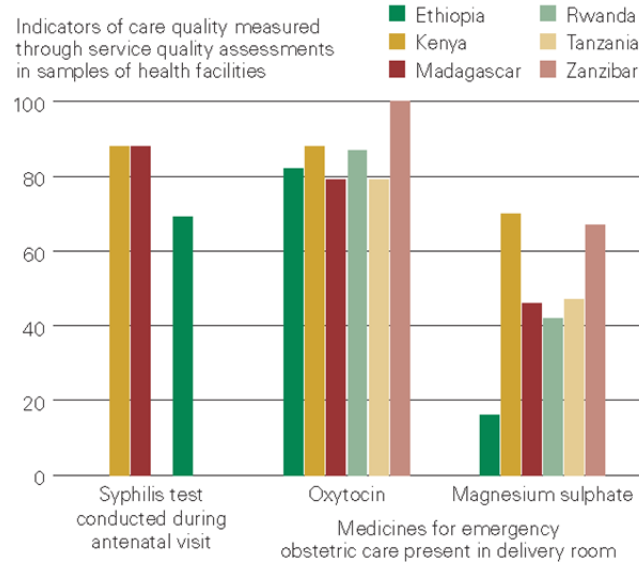

- Page 22, box 8: The footnote in the 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph, in the sentence regarding WHO surveys on anaemia in pregnancy, should be footnote #3 (rather than #2).
- Page 23, figure 9, and page 24, table 2: The indicator label for malaria treatment should read: “Malaria treatment (first-line **antimalarial**)”.
- Page 24, 2nd full paragraph, 1<sup>st</sup> sentence should begin: “At least one country has achieved coverage above 80% for each of **17** interventions...”
- Page 28. Figure 10. The order of the indicator labels should match the data in table 4 (page 27), with indicators sorted from highest to lowest coverage during the period 2006–2011, as below:



6. Page 40, box 15: The 2nd graph represents the composite coverage index [not ‘indicator’] by wealth quintile, in Pakistan, for **2006-07** [not 2005-06], and the data source is “Pakistan Demographic and Health Survey, **2006-07**.”
7. Page 47, box 18, figure 1: The columns for Ecuador and Mongolia should be footnoted as follows: “Not a Countdown country, data shown to reflect variability in IMCI assessments”.
8. Page 47, box 18, figure 2: The third column for ‘syphilis test conducted during antenatal visits’ represents data from Ethiopia (rather than Tanzania), and should therefore be displayed in green, as below:
